American Heartland Cat Show held April 26/27, 2008 (the following weekend) will give any exhibitor who enters at least two cats in the Greater St. Louis Cat Show on April 19, 2008 a discount of \$5 off the first entry and \$3 off the second entry for the American Heartland Show the following weekend. Maine Coon cats already get this discount since the show is honoring their breed, so if the Maine Coon exhibitor enters at least two cats in the Greater St. Louis show, American Heartlands will give them a free grooming space at their show.

Greater St. Louis Cat Club's EB entry fees – first two EB entries \$65 total, three cats \$85 or four cats for \$100.

*No end of row fee for handicapped exhibitors. Signature must be waived for express mail. Portable cages must buy double cage space. CLOSING: Received by 8PM Central Time April 14, 2008

There is no show hotel, however, there is a Red Roof, Knights Inn, Drury Inn and the Holiday Inn Airport North have all taken cats in the past. Please check with hotel to make sure about pet policy.

RULES: All entries should be FELV negative and be inoculated by a licensed veterinarian against Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia, and Rabies. All claws should be clipped; no declawed cats may be entered. All cats must be free of fleas, fungus, earmites and contagious disease. Show management reserves the right to remove from the showhall any entry suspected of any of the above until a licensed veterinarian can make inspection at the exhibitor's expense. Exhibitors should bring cage drapes, litter pans, food/dishes. Litter will be provided.

All Championship, Premiership, and kittens with registration numbers will be scored for CFA regional/national awards. This show will be conducted under current CFA rules. CAGES: Single cages are 21" X 21" X 21"; doubles are 21"X 42"X 21"

LIABILITY: GSLCC will take reasonable care to safeguard the property of exhibitors. Neither the club, its members nor the Kennedy Complex will be liable for any loss or damage. No guard service will be available Saturday evening and all cats must be removed from the show hall Saturday evening. The showhall is climate controlled. Smoking permitted outdoors.

SALES CAGES: Available to exhibitors with at least 1 entered cat on basis of space availability. Kittens less than 4 months of age not permitted in show hall. Litter registration slip required for age confirmation. All animals for sale must be in a cage. **NO CATS/KITTENS WILL BE PERMITTED IN CARRIERS UNDER CAGES.**
