Location: The Illinois Building is on the Illinois State Fairgrounds, just past the entrance at 801 N. Sangamon Ave. We will be open from 3pm—5pm on Friday for setup.

Hours: Check in will be 8am-9am Saturday, judging begins at 9:30. Any cat not checked in by 9am will be marked absent. Show hours published are 9am-4pm. Sunday Judging begins at 11am until finished.

Show Hotels: The Crown Plaza Hotel is the Banquet Hotel. A negotiated rate of **\$119 per night plus \$25 pet fee** is available. Call [\(217\) 529-7777](tel:2175297777) for reservation.

Benching: One benching request per exhibitor will be honored when possible. All requests must be made at time of entry.

Sunday there will be three judging rings. These rings will only be scored for GRAND POINTS. No Regional, Breed or National points will be awarded. Participation is voluntary. TEN placements will be awarded for each Championship and Premiership
